The Center for Education Reform helped launch this movement in 1993, and continues to be the leading voice and advocate for lasting, substantive and structural education reform in the U.S. The Center was founded with a simple, but ambitious, guiding principle: to restore excellence to education by bridging the gap between policy and practice such that great ideas are put into action. Words like "choice" and "accountability" were not in the vernacular when we began, and challenges to ironclad notions of teacher tenure and seniority were considered radical. We make a difference daily by leveraging our national credibility, connections, and local relationships; by delivering results in the halls of power and in the halls of local schools, in collecting and disseminating comprehensive data, research and analysis of the issues and their impact on everyone from parents to policymakers; by ensuring accuracy and accountability in public forums and in the media; and by serving as a clearinghouse for innovation in policy and practice.
