We give thanks for the parents who have resolved not to accept failure or mediocrity anymore and for the myriad of education providers that have ignited a new revolution for transformative education.

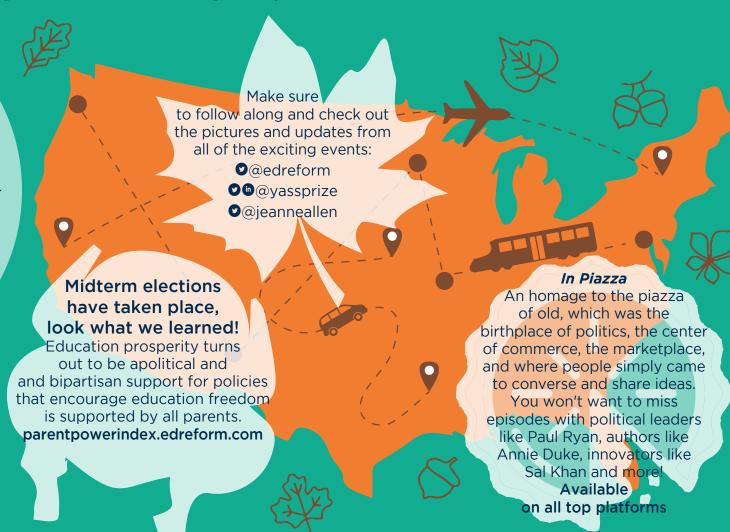
